

Past Life Reading December, 2017

Your past life interests and/or concerns:

Irrational fears, not meeting goals, past life deaths

The first past life that came up:

In the 1900s. I'm picking up a past life as a fisherman on a small boat (maybe 15 feet long by 6 feet wide). Stout, long hair, a graying beard and a beanie. I'm feeling turmoil with the boat rocking, and see a large shark circling and bumping the boat.

The lack of detail here indicates to me a great trauma and/or death occurred during that incident. As small as the boat was it had a tiny inside with glass windshield, I see no sail or oars. You are the only one visible on the boat.

Important Points:

Purpose/ Lessons: "Soul"

The second part to the above purpose is left blank because the second word has no exact translation; something that would translate to a word encompassing the following meanings: enhancement, continuation, and movement.

The second past life that came up:

During the "16th Dynasty." I'm seeing many workers constructing a large gray brick structure, and grassy hills behind it. The side wall of the structure came toppling down. On top of the hill close to the building, you are seen standing in shock and frustration as you watch it come down. Workers are scrambling (they appear to be skilled workers; they are not in peasant clothes). I'm feeling the sense that under your leadership, many other mistakes similar to this one were made.

Important Points:

Lessons: This was a lifetime of repeated mistakes, or failures.

Purpose: "Humility." This life followed a lifetime of being royalty.

The third past life that came up:

You were a powerful man in mid-1400s Japan. You were a well-trained and respected warrior in sword fighting and martial arts, and related to the Emporer. You were stern, and commanded attention of others by your presence alone. People followed your directions without question. When there were signs of civil unrest, you made a well-planned decision to step in and seize the opportunity for yourself, with the intent to not rest until you conquered it (whatever 'it' was, I feel it's a city or larger area). Overall, you made selfish decisions that were not in the best interest of the people, but for much of your life convinced yourself that it was for the benefit of others as well and that you were following the righteous path. Later in life, you vowed to learn humility, but did not accomplish that in this lifetime.

Important Points:

Karmic Relationships: You had a loyal brother, also your best friend and fellow soldier in that lifetime. He or she is present in your life now, holding the same qualities of loyalty to you. This would be someone that has unconditional love and support.

Lessons: "Karmic." "Barrage." (in seeing the word "barrage" I'm sensing a "barrage" of life lessons rather than one major life lesson. One lesson was an on-going multi-lifetime romantic relationship that needed resolving (since resolved and debts paid). Another was "brotherhood."

Other: It should be noted, the visual difference between you then and now is astoundingly similar. You had the same facial structure/ cheekbones and (extremely similar) jawline; an almost identical nose; different shade of skin and slight difference in eyes.
